

APPLICATION FORM TO ENROLL FOR THE GOVERNMENT AUDITING SPECIALISM PROGRAMME (GASP) 2012 (in order to qualify to write the RGA-QE)



- Please ensure that you complete all information required on this form neatly and in block letters. If any documents are outstanding by the closing date (Thursday 12 April 2012 at 12H00), your application may be disqualified as unsuccessful.
- The application form has to be accompanied by a number of documents (checklist provided in the following box) and the prescribed application fees (R3,990).
- GASP applications close strictly on 12 April 2012 at 12H00.
- The success (or not) of your application will only be communicated to you after proof of payment of the application fee (R3,990) has been faxed to the SAIGA Secretariat (012 362-1418).
- If you are not currently a registered SAIGA trainee auditor, you also have to register as a SAIGA trainee auditor in order to enrol for GASP (all GASP candidates have to be registered trainee auditors for the duration of GASP) Use a separate application form (2012) to register as trainee auditor. Your trainee auditor application has to be submitted as soon as you received confirmation that your application has been successful.
- The presentation of the 2012 GASP is subject to the enrollment of a minimum number of candidates to make the programme economical viable.
- If the enrollments justify GASP to be offered in 2012 the first 50% GASP programme fees (R15,105), become payable with immediate effect. No participants will be allowed to attend any lecture if their first fees are not paid.
- GASP lectures commence on 15 August 2012 and the 2012 RGA-QE is written on 14, 15 and 16 November 2012.

- Applications have to reach the SAIGA Secretariat on or before the closing date (12 April 2012 at 12H00).

Fees payable: Application fee R3,990 (R3,500+14%VAT). The application fee is non-refundable.

GASP programme fees: 50% with registration R15,105.00 (R13,250+14%VAT) & 50% after Module 4: R15,105.00.
