Registered as an assessor or moderator.
Knowledge and experience of working in committees

ROLE, DUTIES, RESPONSIBILITIES AND OBJECTIVES OF THE EXAMINATION BOARD (EB)

The Examination Board (EB) shall and subject for SAIGA Council approval:

Quality assurance of the content of the syllabi for the achievement of registration as public sector auditors based on approved competency requirements.

Quality assurance of the content of the syllabi for other training courses and programmes in accountability, auditing, and public sector auditing in particular for persons who are taken up in any register administered by the Institute.

Evaluate qualifications by means of which persons may qualify for membership of the Institute for recommendation to Council.

Provide quality assurance and governance on the conduct of examinations in the Institute.

Quality assurance of examination papers.

Appointment of assessment or examination developers and assessors/examiners.

Appointment of moderators.
